

### Copperleaf Strategy – Third Party Terms

1. **Third Party Components.** Due to certain third-party components within the Software and the terms upon which they have been made available to IFS, the following additional terms apply.
  - 1.1. Customer expressly authorizes IFS to:
    - a) Disclose to its relevant third-party suppliers, solely where and to the extent required by each such supplier (the “Third-Party Suppliers”) that Customer is an IFS customer;
    - b) Permit the Third-Party Suppliers to access and process Customer Data on IFS’ behalf, subject to and solely in accordance with the terms of the Agreement; and
    - c) Permit a Third-Party Supplier hosting organization to store Customer Data at the Hosting location/region indicated in the Order Form.
  - 1.2. IFS will confirm to Customer the identity of the relevant Third-Party Suppliers within a reasonable time following Customer’s request.
  - 1.3. Customer agrees and accepts that use of Microsoft products as a component of the Software is governed by applicable provisions of the Microsoft Customer Agreement at <https://www.microsoft.com/licensing/terms/product/UniversalLicenseTerms/MCA> and, without limitation thereto, Customer commits to comply with the code of conduct at <https://learn.microsoft.com/en-us/legal/ai-code-of-conduct> and the acceptable use policy at <https://www.microsoft.com/licensing/terms/product/ForOnlineServices/all>.
  - 1.4. Any third-party components within the Software may only be used as a component of such Software and not otherwise, unless separately licensed by Customer.
  - 1.5. IFS confirms that the Third-Party Suppliers are bound by obligations of confidentiality substantially similar to those within the Agreement.
