In addition, IFS Business Reporter provides reporting tools that streamline data analysis across these core functions, facilitating comprehensive oversight of financial and procurement operations. The solution also integrates around 30 interfaces, enhancing connectivity with existing systems and ensuring robust data flows.

Strong leadership and team engagement

According to Mikko Isotalo, CEO of Lujabetoni, top management commitment and well-defined internal processes were crucial to the success of the ERP project. "In the cloud environment, there's no point in customization anymore. Our processes and practices must adapt to the ERP," Isotalo emphasizes. "Top management needs to be fully committed, setting the direction, rules, and follow-up for the project. It's also essential to have a dedicated project manager and involve the entire team to ensure buy-in and accountability across the board."

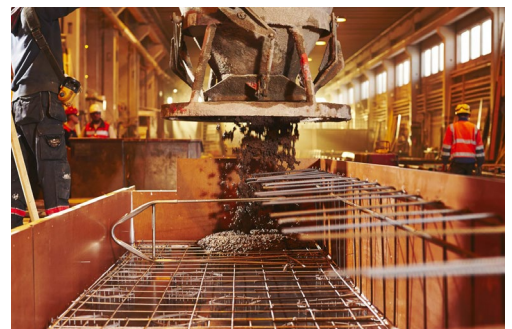

These were followed by detailed specification workshops with IFS, ensuring alignment and a smooth implementation process. "We held tens upon tens of process workshops ourselves and then tens of specification workshops with IFS to finalize everything. The commitment to process precision from the outset was essential."

Project milestones and risk management

The IFS implementation project, lasting just over a year, adhered to its schedule and was delivered under budget, with all key dates established at the kickoff and successfully met. Clear project management and proactive risk management were pivotal in maintaining focus and preventing scope creep, while rigorous testing and quality assurance processes ensured a high-quality delivery.

Data migration, a crucial component, was managed by IFS channel partner Aveso, ensuring that all legacy data was converted into a format compatible with IFS Cloud. "Outsourcing migration tasks is a smart choice, as these are one-time projects. Training in-house IT specialists on migration tools would be inefficient, given that they won't use them regularly," notes Isotalo.

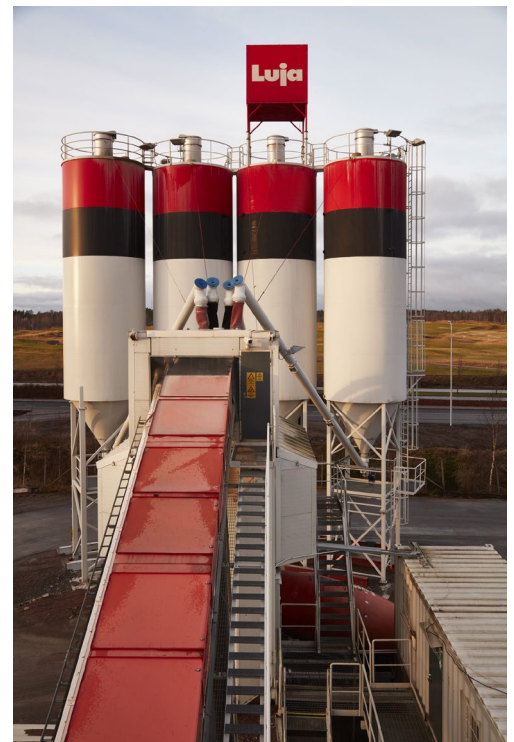
